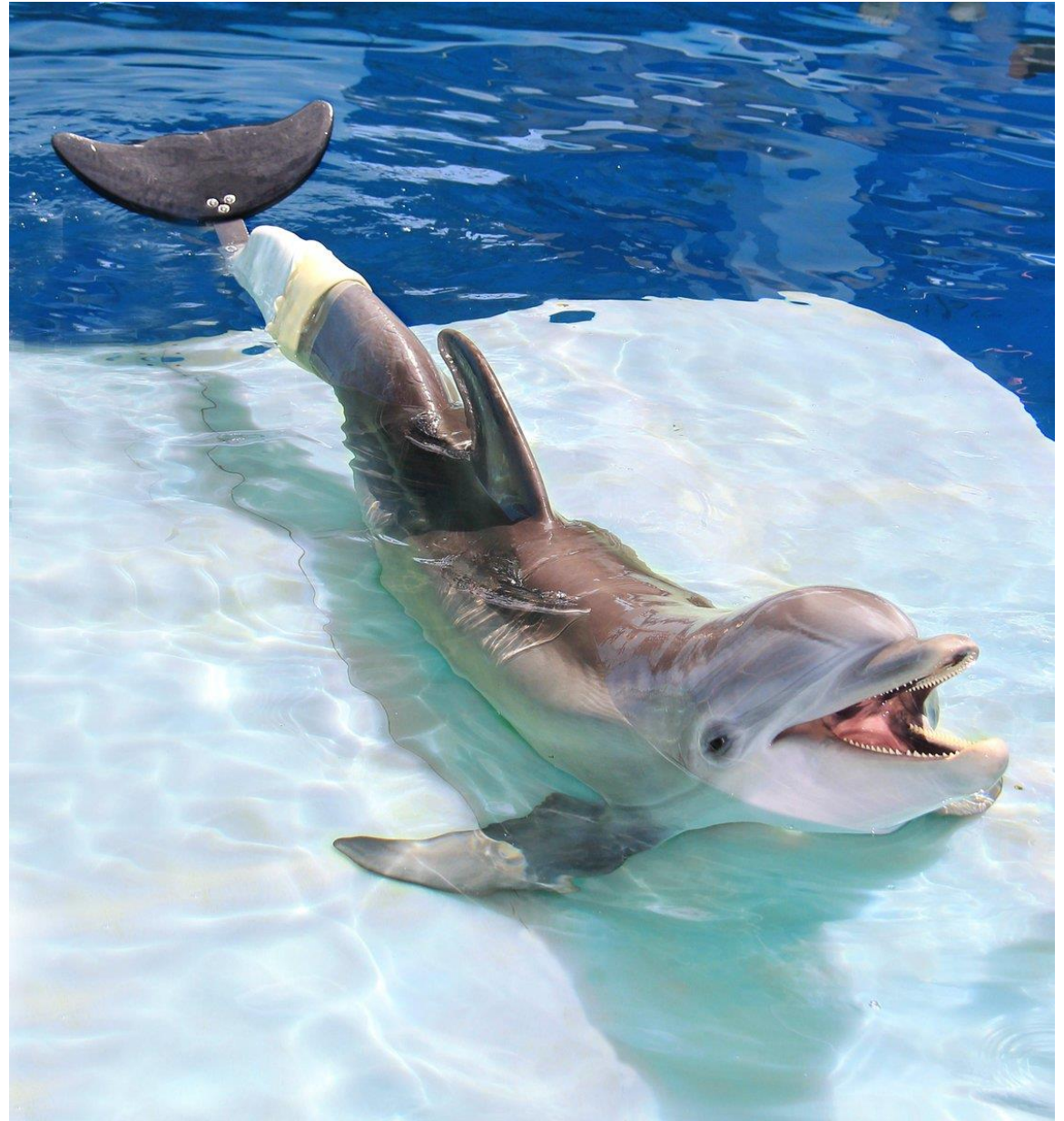



Dolphin gets new tail
