The tower of Pisa in Italy was built as a bell tower for the city's Cathedral. However, at that time, architects did not test the soil. So it was built in soft ground and as soon as it was built, it began to tilt slowly.



Over the years, many attempts have been made to stop the tower from falling. Once people removed the stones from the bottom and installed strong metal rods, but the stones that were removed were part of the Foundation, and so the tower leaned even more! It has since been strengthened to correct it.



Today, the tower can still be seen leaning to one side. It is covered with marble, and it is very beautiful. Unfortunately, it was closed to the public in 1990 after it was discovered that tourists at the top could completely collapse it. And yet, it is visited by tourists for many years to come.
